How it works

Please include the following in your forum post ...

Subject: I'm looking for a Study Buddy!

- Introduce yourself! (What is your experience level? Beginner, Aspiring, Professional?)
- What are you hoping to gain from having a Study Buddy?
- What do you want to work on?
- What do you have to offer your buddy?
- How are you willing to meet/study? (Skype, Email, Zoom, In Person ... etc.)
- Where are you located? (timezone)
- Anything else relevant to your needs!

Rules and Expectations

By posting a request for a study buddy, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- There is no guarantee that you will be matched with a Study Buddy. Buddies are available based on their own time, and there may not always be someone available that matches your needs.
- > You promise to do your best to communicate with your Buddy regularly
 - Be open in your communication if the partnership is not working out, it's OK! Just say so ⁽²⁾
 - If you wish to discontinue your studies, or cancel your membership you must make your buddy aware that you will no longer be available.
 - It is up to you to continue the partnership! Biddy Tarot will not intervene if communication ceases.
 - If this is the case, please post another request for a study buddy!
- Biddy Tarot will not facilitate this process, provide study materials or host meeting sessions for study buddies.
